



DIRECTIONS TO OFFICE VANLANSCHOT-TOREN 'S-HERTOGENBOSCH

By car

Approaching from Utrecht/Amsterdam

Driving in on the A2, turn onto the A59 to Ring Noord-Waalwijk, then take exit 47 on the A59 to 's-Hertogenbosch Maaspoort/Hedel. Continue on Hambakenweg and turn right at the traffic lights into the Zandzuigerstraat. Turn left at the next traffic lights into the Nelson Mandelalaan. Keep driving parallel to the railway line until you see the Van Lanschot-toren on your right. Turn right onto the Leeghwaterlaan. The parking garage is located after 100 metres on the right-hand side.

Approaching from Nijmegen/Arnhem

You drive to Vught from the A50 and A59. Take the exit Knooppunt Vught from the A2/E25. Then take exit 1 Vught Centrum and turn onto the Randweg. Turn right at the second set of traffic lights into the Magistratenlaan. Turn left before the station into the Leeghwaterlaan. The car park is located after 100 metres on the right-hand side.

Approaching from Rotterdam/Dordrecht

Follow the A15 and then take the A2 to 's-Hertogenbosch. For further directions, see Approaching from Utrecht/Amsterdam.

Approaching from Eindhoven/Tilburg

Driving on the A2, follow 's-Hertogenbosch Centrum. Turn right at the fourth set of traffic lights (Magistratenlaan). Turn left before the station into the Leeghwaterlaan. The car park is located after 100 metres on the right-hand side.

Approaching from Waalwijk/Rotterdam

On the A59, take exit 45 Ring 's-Hertogenbosch-West. Follow the Vlijmenseweg, which becomes the Randweg, pass the Jeroen Bosch Hospital and turn left at the fourth set of traffic lights into the Magistratenlaan. Before the station turn left into the Leeghwaterlaan. The car park is located after 100 metres on the right-hand side.

By public transport

Station 's-Hertogenbosch is next to the Van Lanschot-toren. From the station you can walk to the Van Lanschot-toren.

Walking directions (5 minutes)

The Van Lanschot-toren is located in the centre of 's-Hertogenbosch, right next to the train station. Upon arrival you should leave the station at the back (Paleiskwartier, not the city side). You will then reach the Leonardo da Vinciplein, where the Van Lanschot-toren is located.
